FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What does my player need for tryouts?

Players need full hockey equipment for tryouts. Arrive in time to check in and change. Bring two jerseys to every session - one black/dark and one white/light jersey. Both jerseys must have the players last name affixed to the back of the jersey. Please note that we may assign you a jersey color (dark or light) during tryouts and the assigned color may change during tryouts.

What are the start and end dates for the season?

Practices for all CSHL and ADM Mite teams start the week of August 31st and end in late February or early March depending upon playoffs. Teams may schedule practices prior to this date at each team's discretion and an additional fee is collected by each team to cover the cost of those practices.

Do you offer spring and summer teams?

GYHA does not have formal spring and summer teams although some of our coaches run teams during the offseason. Ask your child's coach if you are interested in this. We offer summer hockey camps and information is available online through Gilmour Academy at the following link: <https://tinyurl.com/GACamps>

How many games do teams play?

CSHL teams play between 10-16 regular season games within the CSHL (decided by league & dependnet upon division) and 6-10 pre-season games. Tournaments and non-league games are decided upon by the individual team. Tier 1, Tier 2 and AA Hybrid typically play a 50-60 game schedule.

What do my fees cover?

Your fees cover all ice time, league fees and officials fees for practices, skills sessions, monthly goalie training and games during the CSHL regular season and playoffs (August 31-March). Extra practice time outside of regularly scheduled team practices and any tournaments, non-league games and travel is decided upon by each team and collected from the team and paid for by team administration (coaches/managers).

What are the differences between CSHL and Tier 1/Tier 2/Hybrid?

CSHL teams play a schedule within the CSHL and are placed by the league according to pre-season results. Tier 1 (AAA) and Tier 2 (AA) teams are more advanced, involve more travel and compete on a regional and national level. They are eligible for a bid to the USA Hockey National Tournament. Hybrid competes at the AA level and includes more travel and also plays within the CSHL, however there is no National Tournament at this age. Can I tryout for teams at both the 12U Hybrid and 12U CSHL levels?

Yes. Players may tryout for one or both levels. Players wishing to attend both tryouts should register for 12U AA Hybrid tryouts and select the check box indicating that they also wish to attend 12U CSHL tryouts. By checking this box, you do not need to do another registration for CSHL tryouts. Your child will be added to that list as well and you will only be charged the \$75 tryout fee one time. Players who only wish to attend 12U CSHL tryouts should register for that tryout only. Players registering for and attending only 12U CSHL tryouts will be offered placement on one of our 12U CSHL teams providing space is available. Players who only attend 12U Hybrid tryouts may be offered a placement on that team or not offered a placement. Players who register for and attend both Hybrid and CSHL tryouts will be offered a placement on one of our 12U CSHL teams if they are not offered a spot on the 12U Hybrid team providing space is available. Players **MUST** register for and attend at least 1 tryout session (preferably all sessions) at each level they are trying out in order to be offered placement.

Do I need to attend every tryout session?

No. In order to be offered team placement, you must register and attend at least one tryout session. **Note that missing a session can result in a less-accurate team placement.** If a player registers but is unable to attend at least 1 tryout session, they will be offered a spot on our lowest team at that level provided there is space available.
